Both Cities are interested in bolstering their tourism industry

Both Cities are in the process of revitalizing their downtowns; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has decide to embrace the City of Tequila as our Sister City for the purpose of sharing our culture, ideas, resources, communities, and friendship.
